What is Cornerstone?

Cornerstone is a one-day event to help build participants' spirituality and to connect them with the parish community. It is called "Cornerstone" because Christ is our Cornerstone, the foundation upon which our lives are built. You will experience the opportunity to begin, revitalize or deepen your relationship with Christ in a welcoming environment. Many of us attend Mass, but our busy lives often make it difficult to connect to our community of faith and get to know others in our parish. Cornerstone will help you to make these connections with God and fellow parishioners.

Who can attend Cornerstone?

All are welcome, however there is limited seating and priority will be given to parishioners of Sacred Heart.

Who conducts the Retreat?

A team of parishioners and others who have experienced Cornerstone – and want to pass the gift on to others – will present the retreat under the spiritual direction of our Pastor Fr. Rich Kelly and Fran Orefice, Director of Life-giving Ministries.

What will I experience on the retreat?

Cornerstone takes place on the Sacred Heart property and begins at 8:00 am on Saturday (Women's) and 7:30 am on Saturday (Men's). All meals and plenty of refreshments will be provided. Cornerstone activities **will** help you affirm your own gifts and discover how you can share these gifts for the good of others. It is a fun way to get to know other parishioners and build lasting bonds of trust and support.

Cornerstone consists of short talks followed by small-group discussions, quiet personal time, Reconciliation, and time for socializing. Cornerstone concludes with a closing Mass at 7:30 pm on Saturday. Family and friends are invited to attend this mass. Every team member is dedicated to ensuring an atmosphere of warmth and hospitality. This is a day prepared especially for YOU!
